2007 : Participation in the Grenelle Environment project

- **Our victories**

Contributions to the successive cancellations of marketing authorizations for the insecticides below:

2004 : Prohibition of Gaucho® neonicotinoids on sunflower and Régent TS® on all crops

2005 : Prohibition of the neonicotinoid Gaucho® on corn

2012 : Prohibition of neonicotinoid Cruiser® on rapeseed

2018 : General ban on neonicotinoid insecticides under the 2016 Biodiversity and Landscape French law

2007 : First recovery plan for French beekeeping obtained following the Grenelle Environment project

November 15, 2011 : Massive vote of the resolution of the European Parliament in favor of the majority of the measures presented by Terre d'Abeilles in June 2011 to the European Environment Agency

April 27, 2021 : Publication in *Le Monde* of a opinion column "Beekeeping should no longer be subject to an agrochemical dictatorship with no way out"

November 2021 : Adoption of the revision of the "bee" decree of November 28, 2003 - the only regulation governing the agricultural use of pesticides and aimed at improving the protection of pollinating fauna.

2008 : Creation and opening to the public of Terre d'Abeilles's educational site called Maison des Abeilles (F-36300 Ingrandes)

Conception and realization of a permanent exhibition

2010-2011 : Creation of an exhibition composed of 14 kakemonos
